



## Rutgers Master Gardener Program of Burlington County Volunteer Re-commitment Survey

In order to continue to be a Certified Rutgers Master Gardener you must maintain your good standing by completing the required volunteer hours as specified in the Rutgers Master Gardener Program of Burlington County Policies and Procedures, submitting individual log sheets, signing and returning the county Master Gardener Pest Management Recommendation Agreement and returning this signed re-commitment survey stating that you wish to continue as a Rutgers Master Gardener. You may request a leave of absence for up to one year if you are a Certified MG. After one year of leave, you must re-commit or your program enrollment will expire.
